Suggestions for Improvement:	<p>It was difficult to manage the second grade class when the Smartboard presentation was not ready (not your fault, you had it prepared). An active class is easily sidetracked therefore it helps to have Plan B ready to go. Once started the lesson was well-prepared with age appropriate activities. Remember when you are teaching to wrap-up the lesson when the students are having difficulty focusing. It is better to stop at a high point than to struggle to complete the lesson.</p> <p>Concerned about your management, you relied on your cooperating teacher to get ideas and suggestions on how to best manage an active, talkative class. She is an excellent resource. I suggested you use the microphone and I hope that helped you as well.</p>

Suggestions for Improvement:	<p>You knew the material on "What is a Leader?" However, double check your information so that all data shared with the students is correct. Your activities were varied, visual and had movement. When the students were unable to appropriately handle the activity, you modified it to still assess understanding but kept students seated and focused. Good "thinking on your feet" and adapting the lesson to meet the immediate needs of the students.</p> <p>When giving a consequence for students who aren't listening, follow through. I hope that your visit with Mrs. B helped boost your confidence in this area. "Mean what you say, say what you mean." is a good rule to follow and let's students know you are in charge.</p>

Suggestions for Improvement:	I feel you were well-prepared for your lessons. Remember, you, as the teacher, can adapt, stop or modify the lesson. Your week in second grade was busy.
