<b>General Comments:</b>	<p>Morgan is a very pleasant student to work with. She dresses very professional and has a positive attitude.</p> <p>I do believe Morgan will be an effective student teacher, however, I would like to see some improvement on classroom management during her 2nd full teach week with me in November. While observing her first lesson she struggled to have any control with the class. This could have been due to kids not listening and her getting flustered. The lessons that followed seemed to improve some. I'm hoping in November she will appear to be more comfortable delivering the lessons. I feel that she needs to make sure the students know that she is in charge. While I think Morgan has the skills, knowledge, and positive attitude of what it takes to become an effective student teacher I would like to see her work on the classroom management piece prior to her next full week teach.
